II. BACKGROUND

B.

Berhampore Girls' College college established in 1946, to promote Women Higher Education, is a General degree college in Murshidabad district. It offers undergraduate courses in Arts, and Science. It is affiliated to the University of Kalyani, West Bengal.

The institution intends to achieve its objectives by means of the followings:

IV. IT IS MUTUALLY UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED UPON BY THE PARTIES THAT:

1. Modification : The programme undertaken shall be reviewed Periodically and based on feedback received be modified, if required for optimal output and administrative and operational convenience.
2. Extension : The period of MOU signed may also be extended if found mutually beneficial.
3. Termination :
 - i. Any programme undertaken may be terminated after due evaluation and feedback, if found unproductive and untenable .
 - ii. The entire MoU can also be terminated anytime without being a burden for any party, of course, with a minimum of three months' notice from either side.
