From 02.03.2022 to 08.03.2022

As per the order issued by concern authority, memo No. F. No-P21-2/NSS/RD/KOL/2021-2022/3007-3009, dated 26th October, 2021, the programmer of the special camp have designed and organized in the adopted village, at Abhaypur. The total Report of the activities mentioned below by following the programme schedule day wise. Almost 40 volunteers took part in the special camp.

Day:-1 (02/03/2022) Wednesday:

The volunteers of the unit gathered in the village area, and a sanitization programme is conducted by them some uncleansed drains, logged water area are cleaned, bleaching powder are spread. The primary school campus is also sanitized.

Day:- 02 (03/03/2022) Thursdays :

The volunteers have done a house hold survey at adopted village to collect there socio-economic data, along with a query of their eye problem. The villagers are cordially invited to come in the camp for their eye check-up , going to be held on 04/03/2022, at Abhaypur primary school , by the unit.

Day:- 03 (04/03/2022) Friday :

The proposed Eye camp was arranged in collaboration with Tehatta Sub-division Hospital. Two doctors, one nurse and one attendant were come to attend the patients. Sixty villagers have come to the camp to check-up their eye, out of 20 have found for their cataract problem and are recommended to contact with Tehatta Sub divisional Hospital in due course of time. Villagers of the adopted area are happy for this initiative.

Day:- 04 (05/03/2022) Saturday:

A sports and cultural programme was organized for the children of the school. Games for the children, recitation, musical chair etc. were arranged. Students took part excitedly and took the joy of the game enthusiastically. At last prizes to the best performers are given.

Day:- 05 (06/03/2022) Sunday :

To motivate our volunteers and other stakeholders in social service, a value based webinar was organized in collaboration with Ramakrishna Mission Sikshanmandira, Belur Math , Howrah. Swami Divyagunandaji Maharaj, honourable Principal of the Ramakrishna Mission Sikshnamandira, Belur Math, Howrah, have delivered a talk on the same. Almost 250 Participants joined in this webinar, streaming in YouTube. The insightful deliberation of the resource person illuminated all.

Day:- 06 (07/03/2022) Monday :

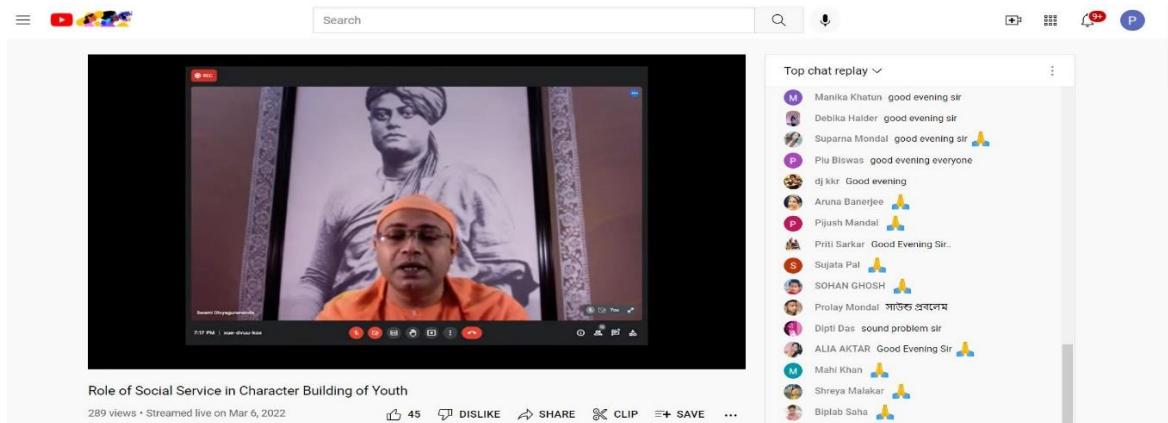
The volunteers have written same slogans in different places of village on several issues like , health, education to promote health awareness among the villagers.

A cultural competition was arranged for the volunteers and prize were distributed to the best achievers.

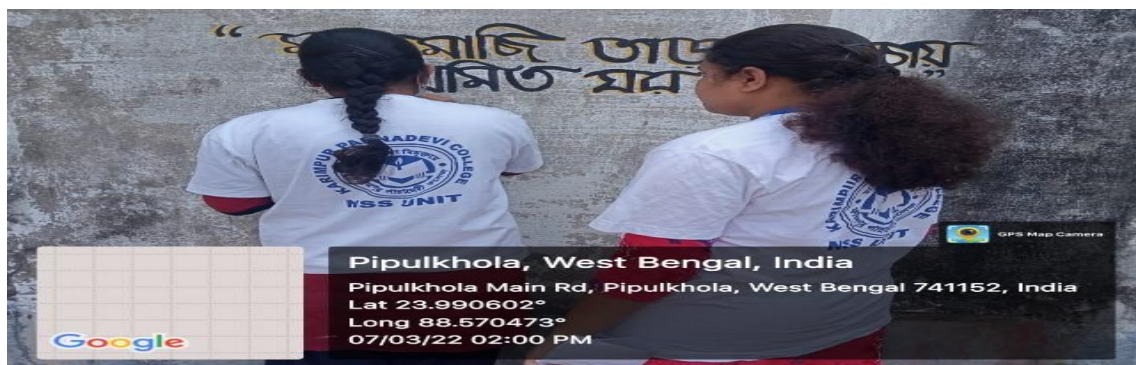
